

- Pastoral care



The United States incarcerates more people per capita than any country in the world. Despite the presumption of innocence built into our criminal justice system, many are held before ever being found guilty of a crime -- often simply because they cannot afford to post bail.

This Sunday, we welcome Jessica Yeary, the Public Defender for our circuit, to talk about the bail system and reform measures. Jessica began her career as an assistant public defender, advancing through the office to the role of felony division chief before being elected Public Defender in 2020. After hearing from Jessica, we will reflect on faithful responses to the criminalization of poverty in our community, state, and nation.

Holy scripture teaches us that God created humankind in god's own image. Christ calls us to love God, with all our mind, soul, and heart, and our neighbor as ourselves. With this comes the sacred responsibility to treat each human being with the love and respect due to a child of God.

We will seek out opportunities to oppose all forms of systematic racism and to ensure that black lives matter, as do those of indigenous, Asian, and Latinx people and persons of all colors or countries of origin.

Our faith tells us that we can do no less, if we truly affirm that all human beings are made in god's image.

We dream of a day in which all persons are treated as bearers of that image.
