

- At First Presbyterian Preschool (FPP),
- We are a play-based preschool.
- There are two teachers in every classroom.
- We serve students ages 2-5 in three classrooms.
 - Ages 2-3 T.C. Bears
 - Ages 3-4 Busy Bees
 - Ages 4-5 VPK

First Presbyterian Preschool

- The preschool and church separate entities.
- The preschool is governed by a Board of Directors.
- The preschool has bylaws and policy guidelines.

First Presbyterian Church

- The preschool and church have a close relationship.
- The church provides in-kind use of space, electricity, and structural building maintenance.
- Both entities are responsible for safety.

Security

- Monitoring security cameras
 - Director, Church Administrator
- Monitoring visitor entry
- Sharing our safety and child protection policies
 - Fire drills, weather alerts, and lock downs
- Communicate with each other in the event of an emergency or potential threat.
- Church staff and members must notify director before entering the preschool.







FPP's Mission

Our mission is to offer a quality education to a diverse group of students.

FPP is one of the only preschools participating in the Florida School Readiness Program.


83% of FPP VPK students experienced learning gains.

Preschool Funding




- Our preschool is small with most revenue generated from tuition.
 - 90% of funds generated go toward staff salaries and benefits.
- There are two Friends of the Preschool campaigns each year with one, the Belinda Kelly Fund, specifically for student scholarships.

• There are some targeted grant opportunities.



Back-to-School Drive

- Many thanks to the First Presbyterian Women for monetary donations collected at the beginning of the school year!
- The donations and the small supply fee from parents allow us to purchase the consumable supplies needed for the year.
 - Ex. pencils, crayons, markers, construction paper, glue, scissors, craft materials



Our Need

- We want to offer consistent full and partial scholarships to 10 families.
- We need more educational equipment and curriculum materials.
- We need to increase safety on the playground and update the turf.
- We need continued support with fundraisers.

Student Scholarships

- We are proud to be a Mission Partner and would love to see the role expanded through sponsorship of families needing assistance.
- We need and would like to offer consistent, month-tomonth assistance.



- **Full** One to two families need full tuition assistance.
 - Approximately \$880 a month
- Partial Three to four families need partial tuition assistance.
 - \$350-\$400 a month
- VPK Summer Five to seven families stop attending because they cannot afford the additional amount during the summer.
 - *\$205* a month







Equipment and Curriculum Materials


Students love manipulatives, educational games, and other materials that make learning fun!

Playground Upgrades

- Increased shading with a canopy and turf maintenance are needed.
