

Unless there is a stay, the execution of Ronald Heath will take place on Tuesday, February 10 at 6 PM.

**Prayer Service:** 9:45 AM on Tuesday, February 10 (*Good Shepherd Catholic Church*). **Candlelight Vigil:** 6:00 PM on Tuesday, February 10 (*Parking lot in front of Governor's Mansion*). **Service of Remembrance:** Noon on Wednesday, February 11 (*FL Capitol rotunda*).

*Additional executions have been set for February 24 and March 3. Identical prayer services, vigils, and services of remembrance will be held for each.*
