This week we conclude our series on “[The Philadelphia Eleven](#)” and the first Episcopal women ordained as priests in 1974. Rev. Mary Piccard Vance and Jane Piccard will share reflections about the extraordinary life and witness of their grandmother, Jeannette Piccard, who was the first of the eleven to be ordained. Before Mary was ordained in 2008 and became the pastor of Fellowship Presbyterian, she was a member of First. As a class, we will consider lessons that struggle teaches about the nature of vocation, the cost of justice, and the ongoing work of inclusion in faith communities.

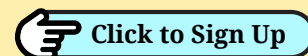
