Execution Vigils in July

Two executions have been scheduled in July. Unless there is a stay, they will take place on the following dates:

- Dennis Sochor, July 14
- Dominick Occhicone, July 28

At 9 AM on the morning of each execution, there will be a prayer service at Good Shepherd Catholic Church.

At 6 PM on the day of each execution, there will be a vigil in the parking lot behind the Governor's Mansion.

At noon on the day following each execution, there will be a service of remembrance for the prisoners and the victims of their offenses around the Great Seal in the Capitol Rotunda.
